RULES GOVERNING PUPILS RIDING SCHOOL BUSES

State of Oregon Rules per O.A.R. 581-53-010

- 1. Pupils being transported are under the authority of the bus driver.
- 2. Fighting, wrestling, or boisterous activity is prohibited on the bus.
- 3. Pupils shall use the emergency door only in the case of emergency.
- 4. Pupils shall be on time for the bus both morning and evening.
- 5. Pupils shall not bring animals, firearms, weapons, or other potentially hazardous materials on the bus.
- 6. Pupils shall remain seated while the bus is in motion.
- 7. Pupils may be assigned seats by the bus driver.
- 8. When necessary to cross the road, pupils shall cross in front of the bus or as instructed by the bus driver.
- 9. Pupils shall not extend their hands, arms, or heads through bus windows.
- 10. Pupils shall have written permission to leave the bus other than at home or school.
- 11. Pupils shall converse in normal tones; loud or vulgar language is prohibited.
- 12. Pupils shall not open or close windows without permission of driver.
- 13. Pupils shall keep the bus clean and must refrain from damaging it.
- 14. Pupils shall be courteous to the driver, to fellow students and passersby.
- 15. Pupils who refuse to obey promptly the directions of the driver or refuse to obey regulations may forfeit their privilege to ride on the buses.

Mt. Angel School District Rules:

- 1. Pupils being transported are under the authority of the bus driver.
- 2. Any activity that prevents the safe operation of the bus by the driver is unacceptable.
- 3. Students must remain seated at all times while the bus is traveling.
- 4. Students must have written permission to ride another bus or be dropped off at any location other than their regular bus stop.
- 5. Students who do not comply with posted bus rules may forfeit their privilege to ride on the buses.

Mt. Angel School District Penalties:

- 1. Serious acts of irresponsible inappropriate, or destructive behavior will result in immediate withdrawal of a student's bus privilege. Such incidents would include:
 - a. Physical assault
 - b. Verbal abuse
 - c. Interference with bus driver or bus operation controls
 - d. Vandalism
