SBAC Math	43%	55%	48%

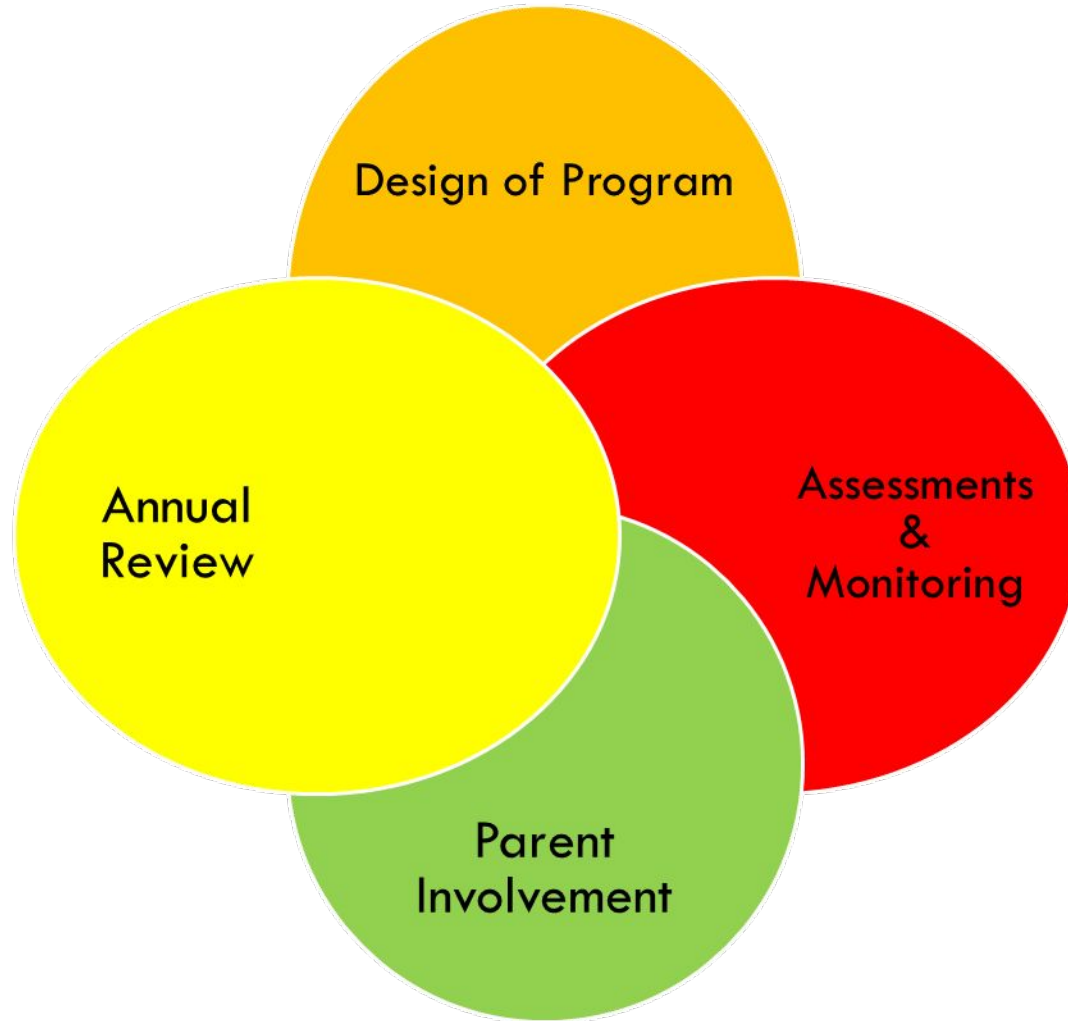

- What is “Title I”?
  - Title I-A is United States Government’s largest education assistance program for schools.
  - Funds are used to provide programs to help children who are struggling in reading and math.
  - Extra help (in addition to what they learn during math and reading time in the classroom)
  - Funding provided under ESEA

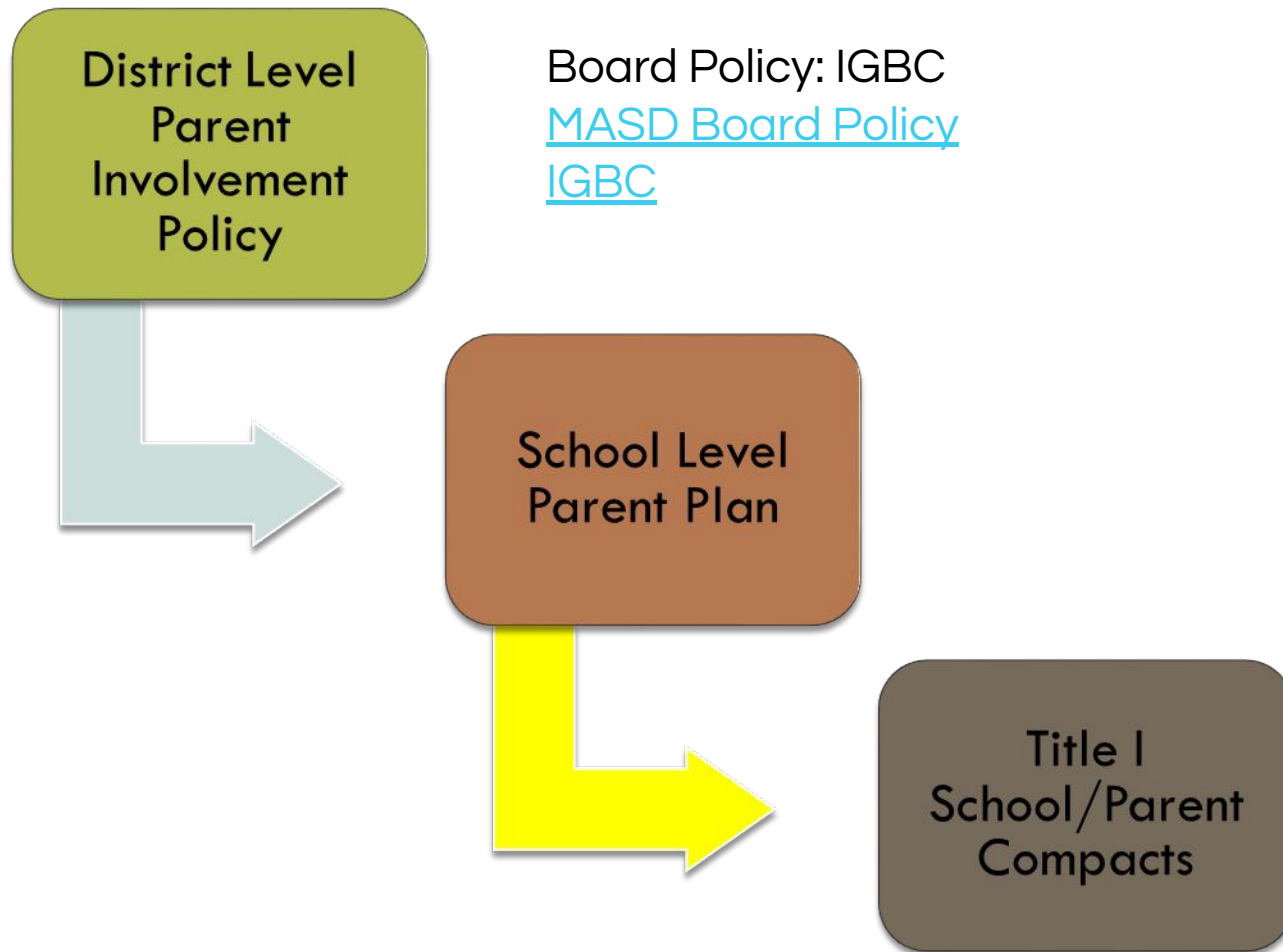

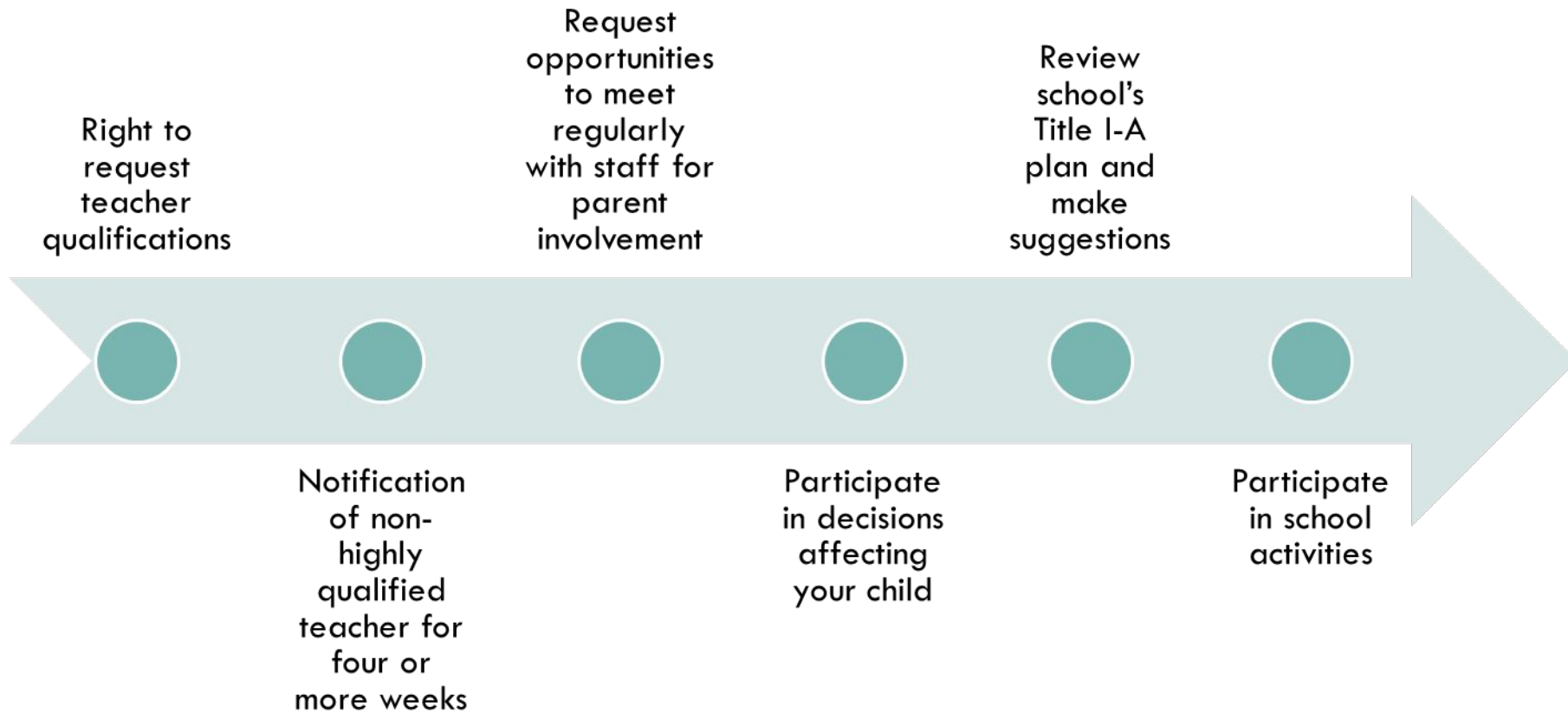
# Assessments & Monitoring

- Assessments our school uses:
  - Yearly - Smarter Balanced, OAKS, KA, ELPA 21
  - Quarterly - EasyCBM, NWEA MAP
- Notification of your child's assessment results
  - SBAC, OAKS, ELPA 21: Annually, reports sent home or distributed at conferences
  - NWEA MAP & EasyCBM: Reports shared at conferences and in the Spring
- Progress monitoring process
